Co-Education

There is co-education in the college. The number of girl students in the session 1966-67 was 8 and in the current session (1967-68) is 36.

Teaching Staff

The college is at present maintaining a teaching staff of ten lecturers, i.e., one lecturer in each of the departments of English, Hindi, Bengali, Political Science, History, Geography, Philosophy, Economics and two in the department of Commerce, and a Principal. The Principal and six lecturers of the departments of English, Hindi, Bengali, History, Geography and Political Science have already got the concurrence from the University Service Commission Vide. USC/APPRC/018/67 No. 567/C/USC dated the 9th March, 1968. All the lecturers are now getting the approved pay-scale of Ranchi University (Rs. 200/-... Rs. 750/- plus 22% of the basis as D.A).

Ministerial & Menial Staff

The college is at present having the services of one Head Clerk-cum-Accountant, One Asstt. Clerk-cum-Librarian and two peons.

An order for the purchase of books for the college Library worth Rs. 4,000/- (Rupees four thousand only) approximately has been placed.

Present Accommodation of the College

At present the classes are held in the D.V.C. Higher Secondary School. The college is free to use four large rooms (seating 80), five small rooms (seating-40) and an auditorium-cum-hall (seating-100). The accommodation and ancillary facilities available at the school are sufficient to meet the present requirements of the college.

Proposed site of the college

The proposed site of the college is a plot of fine land (63 bighas) alongside the approach road to Maithon Dam from Kumardhubi

on the Grant Trunk Road. The foundation of the college building has already been laid out and the plinth upto 3 or 4 feet high has been constructed. The work of the construction was stopped owing to an injunction of the court. The Govt. of Bihar have, however now decided (vide Memo No.11754/DLA-Dhan.9/67(Bt) dated 29-12-67) to hand over the land to the college for the construction of its building and it is hoped that the building will come-up during the next academic session (1968-69).

Building Plan

The plan of the building, having two floors with separate blocks earmarked for the faculties of Arts, Science and Commerce, is indeed ambitious. Hostels for the students and quarters for the teachers are also proposed to be constructed near the College building.

College Hours

The classes are held in two shifts (Morning 6.30 A.M. to 10.15 A.M. and Evening 5-30 P.M. to 9-30 P.M.) The classes of Arts section are held in the Morning shift and those of Commerce section in the Evening shift. Copy of the College Routing for both the shifts are attached with the book-let.

Feeder Institutions

Within the radius of 25 Miles there was no college to cater to the needs of higher education. This college fulfils the long felt demand of the area and has a number of feeder institutions around it. Within a radius of ten miles, there are two Secondary and thirteen Higher Secondary School. The college overlooks the West Bengal border and quite a number of Hindi Speaking students are coming from Kulti, Barakar, Asansol and other neighbouring places in Bengal.
