Visited the B.S.K.College, Maithon on 30th January 1969 along with the Finance Officer. The College was started in the year 1966 and with the efforts of the Principal, Shri Shiva Chandra it has made considerable progress. At present the college is located in the D.V.C. Higher Secondary School. Classes are held in two shifts from 6.30 to 10.30 in the morning and from 5.30. to 9.30 in the evening. Besides Principal there are six other teachers recruited through the University Service Commission and ten temporary teachers

In the morning shift the following Arts subjects are taught : English, History, Hindi, Geography, Political Science, Philosophy, Economics and Bengali

Commerce classes are held in the evening. Regular students are about 60% and about 40% are the workers of the Damodar Valley Corporation. Admissions in some classes are in progress and the class-wise break-up of students are as follows : -

- Pre-Arts - 54
- D.I.Arts - 72
- D.II Prev. - 35 + 1/2
- D.II F-final - 27

- Commerce
- Pre-Commerce - 23
  - D.I.Commerce - 43
  - D.II Com.Prev- 21
  - D.II Com.Final - 20.

The number of girl students in Degree course is 45 and the total number of girl students at present is about 70. The total number of students is about 300. At present there is no honours teaching in any of the subjects. The Principal reports that Honours teaching is in demand for Economics,

Political Science, History, English and Bengali. There are two teachers in each of the above Departments and that no extra staff will be required for starting Honours teaching in the above subjects. The Principal may send concrete proposal for starting Honours teaching in the above subjects.

The new buildings of the college are under construction on the Maithon approach road about one mile from the G.P. Road. The area of the college campus is 21.00 acres and the construction work is going on in full swing. Ten rooms are under construction and roofing has been completed in 6 rooms. It is expected that within 3 months the college will shift to the new buildings, if not earlier. The proposal is for a double storey building. The Master Plan shows provision for staff quarter, hostel for 100 students, play ground, etc.

The Principal was requested to send the copy of the Master Plan so that U.G.C. and Government may be approached for financial help. The financial position of the college is as per appendix 1.

It would appear from the statement that the college has a deficit of about 32,000/- when the U.G.C. scale will be enforced. The D.V.C. is giving a grant of about 6000/- per year. It is reported that most of the employees of the D.V.C. derive benefit from the college and so the D.V.C. be requested separately for enhancing their annual grant. Letters may be addressed separately to the Chairman and Secretary by name from the University requesting them to raise their grant suitably.
